

EVENT INFORMATION



LOCATION

The Shire of York, 90km east of the Perth CBD. Riders should allow time to park and prepare, attend the 7:30am Rider Briefing and short ride out to the start line.

EVENT PARKING

Free parking is available at the York Convention and Recreation Centre. Please see the Event Village Map.

Entry is off Forrest St. Please drive slowly and be cautious when entering and exiting the carpark, as there will be other riders and pedestrians in the area and on course.



TIMING

Every rider will receive a chipped time through WASE Timing. Results will be tabulated on the **WASE timing** website post-event and shared by WestCycle.

Timing chips will be attached to a seat post sticker you'll receive in your Rider Pack.

Be careful not to cross the start/finish line prior to the start as you may record a false time.

RIDER NUMBER

Each rider will receive a Rider Number (and pins) in their registration pack. Pin your Rider number to the lower back area of your jersey.

CUT-OFF TIMES

The cut-off for official timing will be 12:30pm which we do to ensure the safety and welfare of participants as per the event's Traffic Management Plan.

The Event Director has the discretion to direct riders to return to the Event Village, if it is determined that continuing is a health risk. Riders can use the broom wagon to return to the Event Village or if instructed by the Event Director.



EVENT INFORMATION



PRE-EVENT

At the Event Village, riders can access the York Convention and Recreation Centre facilities from <u>7am</u>. Coffee vans will be serving from <u>6:15am</u>.

RIDER BRIEFING

The Rider Briefing will happen in the Event Village at **7:30am**.

RIDER ASSEMBLEY AREA + START TIME

At <u>7:45am</u> riders will be escorted under convoy from the Event Village to the nearby remote start at 54 Knotts Road.

The route is:

- RIGHT onto Forrest Street
- RIGHT on to South Street
- LEFT on to Howick St
- RIGHT on to Macartney St
- RIGHT on to Avon Terrace
- RIGHT on to Knotts Rd

The chip-timed Canola Classic commences at **8am**.


DURING THE RIDE

Food and beverages will be available for supporters and riders in the Event Village throughout the day.

RIDER ETIQUTTE

A few pointers about rider etiquette prior, during and after the event to maximise safety and fun for all.

- Obey the road rules and follow any instructions from event officials and traffic controllers.
- The roads are OPEN, so be aware of other road users.
- Overtake other riders in single file only.
- Keep to the left-hand side of the road and only ride two abreast.
- Be courteous to other riders, teams and officials and other road users.
- If you pull out of the ride, please notify one of the marshals or event staff.
- Please don't litter. Pocket your wrappers and dispose of them responsibly. Litterers will be pulled from the ride.




WINNERS AID STATION

Hydration and nutrition plays a vital role for extended rides such as the Canola Classic, not only for maximising performance but ensuring you complete the ride in a healthy state.

Winners Sports Nutrition and hydration products and bananas and snakes will be available from the Aid Station at the 30km mark near the intersection of Talbot West Rd and Qualen West Road.

EVENT INFORMATION



SUPPORT VEHICLES

Private support vehicles are not permitted on course as they cause unnecessary traffic congestion and inhibit the ability of registered support vehicles to efficiently navigate the route.

HAZARD AREAS

Take care through a section of the course located approximately 13-16km after the start on Talbot Rd that becomes narrow with no centre line markings so riders will need to take the utmost care, stay left and look out for oncoming vehicles.

Please take caution when making the right turn from Qualen West Rd into Talbot Rd heading to the finish line as it is a fast descent down Qualen West Rd.

BIKE MECHANIC

Well serviced bikes make for fun rides. Fully servicing your bike before the event is highly recommended.

Vault Cycle Services will be at the Event Village to provide last minute checks and adjustments. Be sure to drop by and say hi to Richard and grab a business card for all your servicing needs at reasonable prices.

FIRST AID

A St John Ambulance crew will be stationed at the Winners Aid Station and Medical Edge will be following the broom wagon on course.
